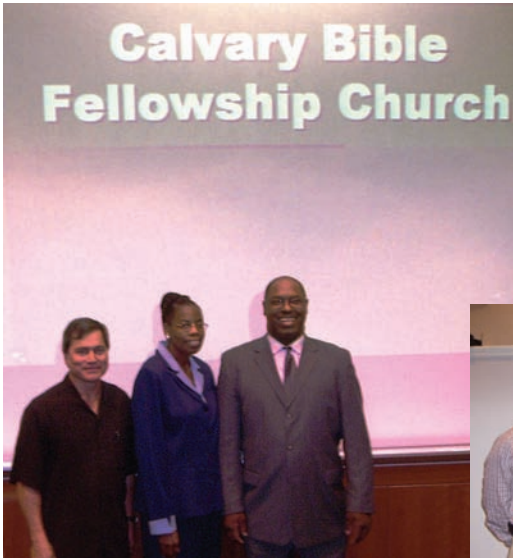
Up Close: Training hundreds in India

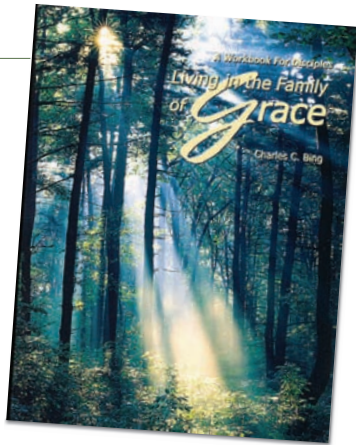
