



A WORD FROM CHARLIE

He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name. John 1:11-12

His friend answered, "It will to this one," and with that he bent down and threw another starfish into the sea.

You and I can't help everyone, maybe not even thousands, but if we help bring one person into the light of God's love and truth, isn't it worth our meager efforts? *I tell you, it makes a difference to that one.*

What Jesus did with His life, in His death for our sins and His resurrection, may not have been received by His own people then or today. Most in the world may not understand the free gift of salvation He provides and so they reject it. What He did makes no difference to them.

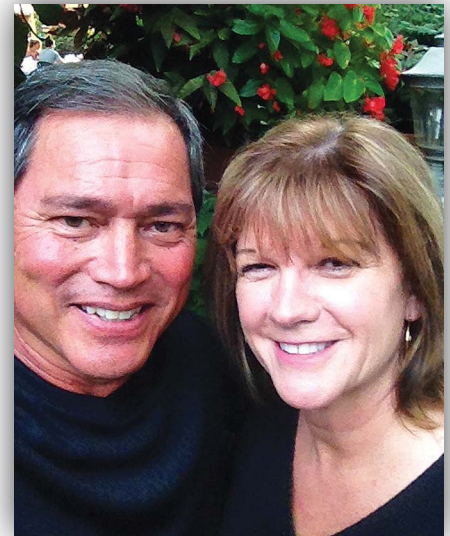
But it made a difference to me.

Up Close: *Grace for Asia*

Note: GraceLife Institute is a four-year, twelve-course certificate program designed for those who need basic grounding in the gospel, the grace message, and basic Bible and theology. GraceLife joins with local ministries to train the pastors and church leaders in their countries using highly qualified teachers who travel at their own expense.



Southeast Asia — GraceLife Institute training, January 3-9.

It is exciting to start GLI training for pastors in a country that has been closed to religious training from the outside. Charlie, John Hardin (Gracelife Church, Pineville, NC), and Steve Hill (Grace Community Fellowship, Eugene, OR) will teach three courses to 40 pastors from all over this country and speak in churches. Also, a new translation of Simply by Grace in their language will be distributed. The cost to GraceLife will be about \$5,500 for conference and pastors' expenses.

India — GraceLife Institute training, January 10-17.

Charlie, John, and Steve will continue on to Hyderabad, India to teach a third year of courses in partnership with Daniel Oswald of Crossworld Ministries International of India and to minister in churches. This will be the third year of GLI training for these 50 pastors. There will be travel, training, and accommodation expenses for the pastors costing GraceLife about \$6000.

Philippines — Word of Life Bible Institute and Pastors' Conference, February 1-14.

These students are future pastors, evangelists, missionaries, and church workers not only in the Philippines, but other Asian countries. Charlie and Richard Grubbs (Biblical Ministries, Inc.) will teach at WOLBI and on the weekend speak to pastors in a special conference. Travel and other expenses will cost about \$3000.

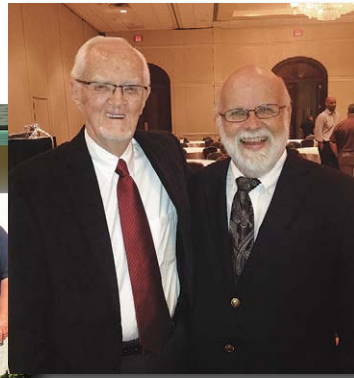

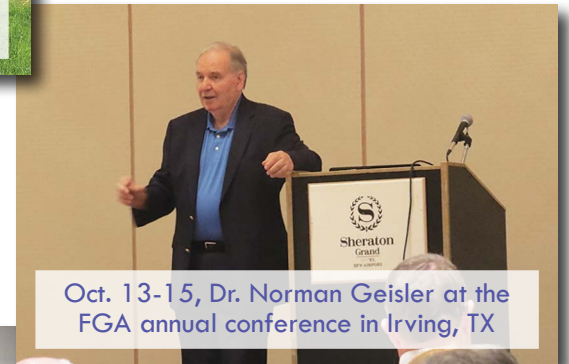

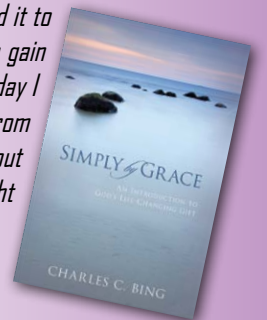
