Communist rocket scientist helped build the nuclear weapons aimed at the United States. But when he came to know Christ, he walked away from an opportunity to become a university president and to earn millions of dollars working with the Chinese on their nuclear program. Instead, he planted Evangelism Explosion ministries in all 12 of the former Soviet republics. This

ministry has led over 120,000 people to Christ in the last 10 years.

Two years ago, GraceLife brought Nicolay to the Grace Evangelical Society's Grace Conference. Now he is excited about sharing the grace message with his national directors in their annual training conference in June. As the Eurasia Director, Nicolay has the freedom to choose speakers and to edit and translate evangelistic literature.


