

A WORD FROM CHARLIE

recently made one of the most exciting, important—and difficult—decisions of my life. I decided to step

down as pastor of Burleson Bible Church and transition into full-time ministry with GraceLife beginning June 1. After much counsel and after discussing it with the church leaders, I announced this to the church in March.

It was a life-shaping decision to start Burleson Bible Church 19 years ago. I thought I would shape the church as pastor, but the pastorate shaped me as a person. In my opinion, there is no vocation that can similarly develop one's character, integrity, creativity,

compassion, flexibility, love, persistence, faith, and much more. My 19 years as pastor of BBC (plus 8 previous years in part-time pastoral work) deepened and defined me as a Christian man. Working so closely with so many different people, stepping up to lead, bowing down to serve, having to prepare fresh biblical messages every week—these are pressures that can turn the character's coal into diamond.

But neither did I know 8 years ago that beginning GraceLife would shape my life forever. My decision was not so much about leaving the pastorate as it was about extending my ministry to meet more opportunities for the grace message. As I see God's hand in it, He used my years as pastor to prepare me for this ministry with GraceLife. I have a deep appreciation for churches, their people, and their pastors. I also have a deep burden for the church's ministry of evangelism and discipleship.

So it is with a great mix of emotion that I step down as pastor of a people I love and a church that is doing well. I step down on good terms and with the church's blessing. I know it will result in something better for the church, for me, and for GraceLife, and I can't wait to see it all come together.

This is a big step of faith for me and the family, a life-shaping decision. Please remember us in your prayers.

After 19 years as pastor of Burleson Bible Church, Charlie will become *full-time* director and president of GraceLife Ministries. He planted BBC with the help of Cleburne Bible Church when he was on staff there and in the doctoral program at Dallas Theological Seminary. BBC is now known as "A Community of Grace."

The church supports his decision to transition to GraceLife full-time. Charlie has offered his help in finding a new pastor.


