Up Close: Overflowing Grace for India

Charlie will lead a GraceLife Team Mission trip to India January 15-29. A group from Stough Memorial Baptist Church (Pineville, NC) will help our host Daniel Oswald in his ministry by training pastors in two conferences, teaching women, working with children, and sharing God's love in the slums. This will be a second visit for Pastor Rodney Cripps.

The message of grace is greatly needed and eagerly absorbed by the pastors and people of this huge and diverse country. Training is always appreciated. One pastor who attended our conference in India wrote.

"Through this conference I was very much blessed. Nowadays no one knows about this message of grace. I believe that everyone should know about this. I am full of happiness."

Another wrote,

"I have attended many conferences. I have NEVER heard anything about grace in

all the conferences with such clarity. I have understood how cursed we were under the law and how Christ came to redeem us from the curse of the law and from this I can sleep peacefully now. Thank you!"

The team will travel to one region where the pastors have never been trained in the grace message. We are trusting God for great things!

Apart from each team member's individual expenses (about \$3000 per person), the conferences and other meetings will cost about \$10,000. If we provide them with

books, it will cost about \$50 per pastor. We really need your help in sponsoring these pastors.

Pray for this mission, for the team, and for the pastors and people who will hear the liberating message of God's glorious grace.
