and evangelists are grounded in the clear gospel of grace? I hope to at least begin that process and find out this summer.


Ghana is a country the size of the state of Georgia with 24 million people, most of whom are nominally Christian but sadly confused about the freeness and implications of the gospel in relation to eternal security, assurance, and the role of works. The result is mass insecurity and a religion of legalism in the name of Christianity.

In July I will lead a team to continue our training of a select group of about 100 pastors and women leaders. We have invested years in them and will graduate our first class this summer! These leaders are becoming well-grounded in grace.

Then in August I have been invited by Ghana's largest evangelism ministry to speak at their two annual pastors' conferences to 1,200 pastors. For most this will be a unique exposure to a clear and consistent gospel of grace.

I'd like you to be a part of these fantastic opportunities. Please read inside so you can pray for our needs. I will be honest with you——I need your help to bring the grace message to the leaders.

It will be a long summer, so I am taking a little vacation time with my family in June. It's good to know I can rest in God's grace and in your prayers. Blessings on you!

First Team Mission, July 9-22:

Purpose:

To train Christian leaders in Bible and theology and to support our local missionary host, Fred Amoah Darko.

Ministry Specifics:

In Accra — First leadership conference, church anniversary conference, women's training, visit schools, preach in churches, work on Fred's house.

In Abetifi — Second leadership conference, women's training, visit schools.

In Kumasi — Third leadership conference to introduce the grace message for the first time in this city!



Costs:

Each team member must raise about \$3500. Conferences will cost GraceLife about \$10,000 plus any literature we can bring.

Needs:

Second Mission, August 26-September 10: Purpose:

To speak to 1200 pastors in two conferences (Accra and Kumasi) at the invitation of Challenge Enterprises of Ghana. Almost all of these pastors have not heard a consistent grace message!

Ministry Specifics:

Charlie will preach twenty messages at the two conferences. Seminary students Rich Keller and Ray Young (who are also husbands, fathers, and engineers) will help and work on practical ministry projects for their missions course.

Pastor Phil Congdon (New Braunfels Bible Church, TX) writes:


