



A WORD FROM CHARLIE

In a recent meeting with a group of pastors

in India they told us what a person had to do to be saved. Though they had more, here are the top ten:

1. Believe in Jesus Christ as Savior.
2. Repent of all of your sins.
3. Be baptized.
4. Practice God's Word.
5. Submit to Jesus as Lord of your life.
6. Go to church every Sunday.
7. Love one another.
8. Be faithful into death.
9. Be empowered by the Holy Spirit.
10. Love your neighbor.

Then we taught them the grace message. At the end of the first day, one said to us in front of the group, "Your words are like honey on our lips; they make us hungry for more!" So we continued to teach--Romans, Galatians, grace versus law—and by the end of the conference we could find no one who was trusting in what he did, but every pastor testified that his faith was in Jesus and what He did. We didn't just teach hundreds of pastors, but hundreds of churches!

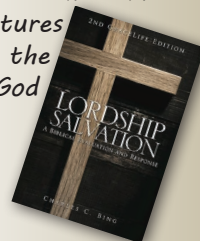
Encouraging Words

Things to Come

 In June Charlie and Karen travel to Moscow for a pastors' conference. Charlie, along with pastor Kenny Hodges of Emmanuel Baptist Church (Starkville, MS) will assist George Bryson, who plants Free Grace churches in Russia. Over \$3000 is needed for expenses.

 In July a GraceLife team travels to Ghana to continue the training of pastors for Ambassadors for Christ with Fred Amoah Darko. Charlie will not be going, but the team will be led by Ghana veteran Dr. Roger Fankhauser. They will start a new cycle of modular training in three cities. The conferences will cost about \$12,000.

 In August, Charlie leads a team to Burundi and Kenya for two pastors' conferences. These missions will cultivate the fruit seen from the 2009 visit. Much teaching is needed because many of these Christians are steeped in legalism that comes from

an unclear gospel. The conference expenses alone will total more than \$20,000.
