Once, as a child, I took a 300-mile train ride. It seemed like it would never end--although it did take all day. So when I heard that Pastor Asa traveled three days on a train from northeast India to attend our GraceLife training in south central India, I was greatly humbled.

Pastor Asa, along with the sixty other pastors, loved our training and wants us to train in northeast India. Looking back on my March trip, I was able to teach the gospel of grace in the far southern tip of India, then in the south-central region to this pastor from the northeast. Not only that, but we released the Telagu translation of Simply by Grace and handed it out to our



All that to say, in a country of 1.3 billion (3% "Christian"), we can't do enough, but we can do something. Likewise, in Myanmar (Burma) we trained over forty pastors and handed out the Burmese translation of my book. Now it is ready to be printed in another major dialect there, Tidem Chin. *Grace is going out—by His grace!*

After a trip to Trinidad and Tobago to teach in a seminary in June, I will lead a team of ten to Ghana (West Africa) in July where we will train pastors and share the gospel in schools and communities.

Sound pretty busy? Sure, but I told the Lord I'll go wherever He sends me and as far as the money takes me. Yes, even in God's plan, it takes money. That is why I am so grateful to you who have supported me and GraceLife as we help rescue the perishing and train others who are doing that.

This will be one of my last appeals for help in the final push for our July Ghana trip. Thank you in advance for letting the Lord use you!

Though there are many nominal Christians in Ghana, most believe that salvation is by works. Our emphasis in




