PAST: We burst into January training 24 pastors in GraceLife Institute in Yangon, MYANMAR." Jason Friesen stayed the first week, then Steve Hill, John Hardin, and Charlie flew north to speak in three churches and lead a conference on the gospel for about 80 people and distribute the book *Simply by Grace* in the Chin language. We saw many respond to the invitation to believe in Christ as Savior and many got excited about the grace message.





February began with ministry in the PHILIPPINES at the
Word of Life Bible Institute. Roger Fankhauser and
Charlie taught 35 students and spoke in churches and
other meetings. We traveled with a work team from
Burleson Bible Church (Charlie Brown, Tom Wagner,
Margie Jackson). The students were very excited about
learning the Bible. In other meetings many made
professions of faith in Christ.


