

Some Notes from the Vineyard




"Teaching hermeneutics and homiletics in higher education for the last twenty years, I have discovered that many students experience great difficulty interpreting various Scriptures because they don't understand the difference between what Dr. Bing describes as A truth (salvation/justification passages) from B truth (passages that address sanctification/discipleship). 
